

Build a Home for Ezra's Hedgehog

You will need

- A Cardboard Box
- Shredded Paper
- Carrier Bag
- Dry grass
- Leaves
- Twigs



Method

1. Find a quiet, sheltered space where our hedgehog won't get disturbed.
2. Cut holes in your cardboard box to make windows and a door.
3. Use shredded paper to make a comfortable bed for your hedgehog.
4. Add dry grass to make the bed comfier.
5. Cover the house with the plastic carrier bag to make it waterproof.
6. Decorate the house with leaves and twigs to camouflage it.
